TAFE courses at Macarthur Diversity Services

A variety of TAFE courses are being run at Macarthur Diversity Services in partnership with Campbelltown TAFE – Outreach Program

Opportunity is provided for people from Culturally and Linguistically Diverse background:

- 1) English classes: to improve language skills. Classes cover very basic English and are running at MDSI on Monday's and Thursday's starting Monday 27 July for 17 weeks from 9:30 am – 1:00 pm
- 2) Introduction to Child care studies for women; subjects cover child play, a practical and a placement at a child care centre. The aim of this course is to provide language skills for studying or working in the childcare field, language support for child development, language support for First Aid and First Aid. The course is running at MDSI on Tuesday's and Thursday's for semester 2 from 9:30 am – 2:00 pm
- 3) Introduction to Community Services Course: knowledge of government and non government organisations and community services; subjects cover level of government (local, state and federal), educational services (AMES, TAFE, colleges, schools and institutes) and community services. The course is running at MDSI on Mondays for 16 weeks starting Monday 3rd August from 9:30 am – 1:00 pm

Courses are during school term's only not during the school holidays
